---Notice---

Some beads shown on the card are dyed, galvanized or plated. The colors on the outer layers may come off, if rubbed, or if soaked in the strong solvent. Those beads are marked at the name of articles and groups on the cards as below.

**----outside dyed, galvanized or plated colors *----inside dyed colors

Silverline beads are oxidized while apply on certain fabrics that are acidic, they may decay or turn dark due to the chemical change. In order to avoid such case, neutralize your fabrics and threads before embroidering.
